SUBJECT: Transit Service Work Plan for August 2016-17

DISCUSSION:

Planning staff has begun developing the 2016-17 work plan. The primary element of the work plan is the service planning effort of which potential service changes are evaluated throughout the year, recommended to the Board in the Spring and implemented in August 2017. The following are initial priorities identified by staff:

Carpinteria:

- Line 20/21x/Seaside shuttle: Review routing as a result of the Via Real extension to Linden Avenue proposed for completion in 2020
- Line 20: Review increasing frequency from 40 to 30-minute service during the mid day weekdays.

Goleta:

- Last mile service
- Line 25: Review increasing frequency

Santa Barbara:

- Last mile service
- Downtown-Waterfront shuttle service (agreement with City expires June 2017)

SBCC:

• Line 15x: Review routing to provide more direct service to SBCC and developing areas in Goleta.

Schedule Adherence:

- Lines 6/11
- Line 10
- Lines 20/21x

The service work plan will also involve close coordination with the City of Carpinteria and Caltrans regarding the construction timing and phasing of the four-year Linden Avenue/Casitas Pass Interchange project proposed to begin later this year and the two year Carpinteria Avenue Bridge Replacement Project at Carpinteria Creek proposed to begin in 2018.

Lines 20 and 21x use the Carpinteria Avenue creek bridge to access the neighborhoods and businesses in eastern Carpinteria and the Seaside Shuttle uses the Casitas Pass Road interchange to traverse over Highway 101 to access the neighborhoods and schools north of the highway. Staff will also need to coordinate with SCBAG regarding the Linden/Casitas Interchange Project Traffic Management Plan which includes \$250,000 in Caltrans funding for regional transit service.
