

## **System Ridership Report: December 2015**

System-wide ridership decreased 14.2% for the month of December as compared to December 2014. UCSB was in session for 6 fewer days in December this year, partly accounting for this decrease; UCSB student ridership per class day decreased 7.4% compared to December 2014. SBCC enrollment for Fall was down 3.8% from last year, and SBCC student ridership per class day decreased 13.9% compared to last December. EF School had 114 fewer students enrolled in December this year, and EF enrollment is down by 19%, or 896 students, for the year so far. Estimating that each EF student rides the bus twice a day on average, this enrollment reduction could account for another significant part of the ridership decrease.

## **External Factors Affecting Ridership**

**Service Days & School Days:** Service days for December 2015 were the same as for December 2014. SBCC and the secondary schools were all in session one less day this year than last year, and UCSB had 6 fewer class days this year.

## **Addendum: Data Source Documentation**

GFI Genfare data is taken directly from the electronic farebox system on each MTD vehicle so equipped. In general, GFI data has not been verified, modified, adjusted, added, or removed since being captured at the time of the driver/passenger transaction. GFI data is considered raw data.

Passdat program accuracy is determined by the amount of GFI farebox data that remains unchanged as compared to Trapeze Run and Trip templates for the evaluation time period. Both human and mechanical errors influence the need to make manual adjustments. These corrections are defined and determined by evaluation of historical and experiential ridership patterns.
