

System Ridership Report: June 2015

System-wide ridership decreased 1.8% for the fiscal year, and 4.8% for the month of June. Of the annual ridership decrease, 42% was in the free and transfer fare categories, which might be seen as good news, but 40% was a reduction in full cash fares, with the biggest decreases on Lines 11, 6, and 2. The number of passengers counted on the Downtown-Waterfront shuttles continues to drop as well, but UCSB students rode the bus more than ever this year, helping to make up for declines in other passenger types.

External Factors Affecting Ridership

Service Days & School Days: There were the same number of days of each service type in June 2015 and June 2014. The secondary schools were in session for 4 more days this year than last year, and UCSB had one additional day of summer session classes this year, while SBCC had 9 more class days than last year. SBCC is offering two summer sessions for the first time this year.

Weather: Average temperatures for June 2015 were about 2° warmer than normal, but significantly cooler than in June 2014, when the "June Gloom" failed to materialize. In June 2014, only a trace of rain fell, but in June 2015 the area received about 0.3 inch one day and a trace of measurable rain on another gray, drizzly day.

Addendum: Data Source Documentation

GFI Genfare data is taken directly from the electronic farebox system on each MTD vehicle so equipped. In general, GFI data has not been verified, modified, adjusted, added, or removed since being captured at the time of the driver/passenger transaction. GFI data is considered raw data.

Passdat program accuracy is determined by the amount of GFI farebox data that remains unchanged as compared to Trapeze Run and Trip templates for the evaluation time period. Both human and mechanical errors influence the need to make manual adjustments. These corrections are defined and determined by evaluation of historical and experiential ridership patterns.
