

System Ridership Report: April 2016

System-wide ridership decreased 8.1%, or more than 55,000 passengers, for the month of April as compared to April 2015, but there was one less weekday service day. UCSB had one more day of classes, while SBCC and the secondary schools were in session for one less day this year. Per-weekday total ridership decreased 6.7% from April 2015. There were six cruise ship visits in April 2016, the same number as in 2015, but perhaps because there was one more weekend service day, shuttle ridership increased for the month.

Service Days & School Days: There was one less weekday service day in April this year and UCSB was in session for one less day, but SBCC and the secondary schools each had one more day of classes this year.

Weather: Average temperatures for April 2016 were a bit warmer than in April 2015, but about 2° cooler than 'normal' for the month. There was slightly more damp weather and we received 0.5" of rain this year – vs. only 0.2" in April last year.

Addendum: Data Source Documentation

GFI Genfare data is taken directly from the electronic fare box system on each MTD vehicle so equipped. In general, GFI data has not been verified, modified, adjusted, added, or removed since being captured at the time of the driver/passenger transaction. GFI data is considered raw data.

Passdat program accuracy is determined by the amount of GFI fare box data that remains unchanged as compared to Trapeze Run and Trip templates for the evaluation time period. Both human and mechanical errors influence the need to make manual adjustments. These corrections are defined and determined by evaluation of historical and experiential ridership patterns.
