

System Ridership Report: June 2016

System-wide ridership decreased 11.7%, or more than 61,000 passengers, for the month of June as compared to June 2015, leaving total fiscal year ridership 8.1% below that for last year. SBCC ridership per summer session class day decreased 24% compared to last June. UCSB ridership increased 6.3% per Spring Quarter school day and increased 4.7% per Summer Session class day, but because there were two fewer days of regular classes this year, total UCSB ridership was down for the month. Non-student ridership also decreased 11.7% for the month of June, and decreased 9.6% for the fiscal year.

Service Days & School Days: There were the same number and type of service days in June this year and last year. The secondary schools and UCSB were in regular session for two fewer days in June this year, but UCSB had two additional days of summer session. SBCC also had two additional days of summer session classes.

Weather: Average temperatures for June 2016 were slightly cooler than in June 2015 on average, but the highs were higher and the lows were lower. There was a little more "June Gloom" this year than we've had the past couple of years, but almost no precipitation.

Addendum: Data Source Documentation

GFI Genfare data is taken directly from the electronic fare box system on each MTD vehicle so equipped. In general, GFI data has not been verified, modified, adjusted, added, or removed since being captured at the time of the driver/passenger transaction. GFI data is considered raw data.

Passdat program accuracy is determined by the amount of GFI fare box data that remains unchanged as compared to Trapeze Run and Trip templates for the evaluation time period. Both human and mechanical errors influence the need to make manual adjustments. These corrections are defined and determined by evaluation of historical and experiential ridership patterns.
