Request for Qualifications for On-Call A&E Services

Addendum Number 2 – Issued May 11, 2020

The Santa Barbara Metropolitan Transit District (MTD) herewith issues this Addendum No. 2 to its *Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Architectural and Engineering (A&E) Services* (RFQ issued on April 9, 2020). In accordance with section 1.4 of the Solicitation Instructions, questions were received that resulted in the below changes to the RFQ. Except as modified by this addendum, all other terms and conditions of the RFQ remain unchanged.

MTD Initiated Changes or Clarifications

THE FOLLOWING CORRECTIONS, MODIFICATIONS OR ADDITIONS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE BID DOCUMENTS AND SHALL BE TAKEN INTO PROPER AND FULL CONSIDERATION BY BIDDERS WHEN PROVIDING A SUBMITTAL FOR THE ABOVE NAMED PROJECT.

A2-1. Section 2.3 of the *Solicitation Instructions* states: “MTD will not accept hand delivered submittals for this solicitation.” The preceding sentence should read: “MTD’s office building at 550 Olive Street in Santa Barbara, CA is closed to visitors until further notice due to COVID-19. As a result, offerors cannot hand deliver their submittal to an MTD employee. However, as an alternative to mailing your submittal, offerors may drop their submittal through the mail slot to the right of MTD’s entry door at the foregoing address. Note that all submittals, whether mailed or dropped through the mail slot, must be received by the deadline.” Due to the last-minute issuance of this addendum, offerors who have already mailed their submittal to MTD will not be penalized for failing to note Addendum No. 2 on the *Acknowledgement of Addenda* form.
