- 7. All iron, steel, cement, and manufactured products used in for this project shall be produced in the United States, in accordance with Buy America per *FTA Contract Provisions*.
- 8. It will pay prevailing wages and make available evidence of its compliance, and its subcontractors compliance, with general prevailing wage rates.
- 9. Its bid has been thoroughly checked for errors and omissions and the costs, prices, hours, rates, and any other constituents of this Price Bid are a complete and correct statement of its price for performing all project work required by the Contract Documents (do **not** include the cost of local agency permits).
